FLOWER & MEMORIAL POLICY

(Please help us maintain the burial plots on this Sacred Ground, by observing our cemetery regulations)

- ♦ **FUNERAL FLOWERS** - The flowers may be stood up or placed flat on the grave depending upon the weather conditions, the number of flowers, and the amount of space in which to display them. The flowers will remain on the grave 3 to 4 days after the funeral service.
- ♦ **FLOWERS** - Artificial or real flowers are allowed year-round, only in approved permanent or plastic cemetery vases and are not to be placed all over the grave. Flower containers of GLASS, PORCELAIN, CERAMIC, POTTERY or CANS are not permitted, and will be removed.
- ♦ **YEARLY CLEANUP** - Once a year in the Spring ALL flowers, decorations, holders or any other non permanent memorial will be removed from all graves and discarded. We ask that you do not put any thing out during this week.
- ♦ **PLANTINGS AND LANDSCAPING** - All work and all planting of any kind on all lots and graves is strictly prohibited, except with the permission of the Parish Office. The digging of holes for any purpose whatsoever is strictly prohibited.
- ♦ **MEMORIAL POLICY**— All monument and markers are to be approved for size and design of memorial, along with placement of memorial on lot or grave.
- ♦ **MEMORIAL STONE**— Monument and markers are to be made of Granite or Marble only. Any other type of natural or man made stone, metal or wood will be removed from lot or grave.
- ♦ **MEMORIAL DEALERS**— Only approved Monument Dealers are allowed to set memorials in Cemetery. No individuals are allowed to set any type of memorial.

NO ITEMS OF ANY KIND ARE TO BE PLACED ON GRAVES, SO THAT LAWN MAINTENANCE CAN BE DONE IN A NEAT AND TIMELY MANNER. ANY ITEMS ON GRAVES WILL BE REMOVED.

All items which are deemed by St. Mary's Parish Office to be in violation of the Rules and Regulations will be removed and discarded. Mount Calvary Catholic Cemetery is not responsible for any item which is discarded or any upkeep of memorials. Further, neither St. Mary's Roman Catholic Church nor the Roman Catholic Diocese of Memphis is responsible for any items placed on a place of interment and/or removed from a place of interment or the upkeep of memorials.
