


Comments from Deacon Dale Brown

Christ's baptism in the Jordan reveals two central truths of Christianity, one of which we think about a lot, and the other of which we hardly ever think about. The one we think about a lot is the fact that Christ is the promised Savior, the Messiah. He is the one described by Isaiah in the First Reading, the one God sent to take away the sins of the world and inaugurate a new, everlasting kingdom of justice and love. His baptism makes this evident by the descent of the Holy Spirit and God's voice ringing out from heaven. The truth of Christianity that we think about less often is that of the Blessed Trinity. We always pray in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. And profess our belief every Sunday, when we pray the Creed, in the true God who is one and three: one in divine nature, and three in persons. The Father is fully God, the Son is fully God (he existed before his incarnation), and the Holy Spirit is fully God. All three are eternal, uncreated, and divine - separate persons, but one God. We don't believe in three Gods, but only one. And yet, that one God is three divine Persons. All three show up at Christ's baptism. The Son is Jesus. The Holy Spirit is the Spirit of God descending upon Jesus like a dove, from heaven. And the Father is the voice from heaven saying, "This is my beloved Son." The reason we don't think too much about the Trinity is because it's really hard for us to understand. But now and then we should think about it - after all, God revealed it for a reason.






Nomination for St. Mary's - Mater Dei Award 2026

On February 15, 2026 our parish will celebrate our annual feast day honoring Our Lady of Lourdes. As part of our celebration, we will have the presentation of the Mater Dei Award. The purpose of this award is to honor those who have rendered outstanding Christian service to St. Mary's Parish for at least five years. Nominees must be confirmed Catholics at least 18 years of age. (Employees of the school and parish are excluded from nominations).

The Mater Dei (Mother of God) Award was established in 1991 and to date has been given to over 70 former and present parishioners. Any confirmed parishioner age 18 or older may submit a nomination, as well as any group or organization.

The deadline for submitting nomination forms is Sunday, January 18, 2026. Completed nomination forms may be submitted to the Parish Office by mail or in person, or dropped in the specially designated box in the Narthex. UPCOMING FEAST DAYS AND SPECIAL DAYS:

Tues., Jan. 13 FEAST DAY of **St. Hilary of Poitiers**, a 4th century defender of the divinity of Christ, devoted to writing some of the greatest theology on the Trinity. He is patron saint of scholars, students & theologians.

Sat., Jan. 17 FEAST DAY of **St. Anthony**, a Christian monk from Egypt. He is considered the “Father of monasticism” in Christianity. Though having lived a solitary life in the desert for 15 years, he came forth for 6 years to instruct and organize a community of monks. His task accomplished, he withdrew to the desert for another 45 years. He is often invoked against infectious skin diseases which include shingles (often referred to as St. Anthony’s Fire).
